



## **Tour Notes: 1-Day Tour of Cape Leveque with Cygnet Bay Pearl Farm and One Arm Point**

### **TOUR HIGHLIGHTS:**

- Mother of Pearl Shell Alter at Beagle Bay
- Tour of Cygnet Bay Pearl Farm
- Tour of Trochus Hatchery at One Arm Point
- Observe tidal flows off One Arm Point
- Swim on a pristine beach east of Cape Leveque
- Afternoon sun on the red cliffs of Cape Leveque

This tour will suit those looking for a full day that's a little more leisurely than mud crabbing and who are interested in the unique opportunity touring a working Pearl Farm.

**TOUR ITINERARY:**

Visit Beagle Bay Aboriginal Community to view the beautiful Sacred Heart Church, famous for its pearl shell altar. Drive north to Cygnet Bay Pearl Farm, Australia's oldest operating Pearl Farm. Enjoy an informative 1-hour tour where you will learn about the family history, the process of culturing pearls and witness the day-to-day life of a pearl farmer. This is an opportunity to purchase pearls from last year's harvest direct from the farm and is followed by a fantastic lunch prepared by the farm's chefs. Drive to One Arm Point Aboriginal Community and visit the local aquaculture hatchery to see turtles, barramundi and other forms of marine. We observe the start of the Buccaneer Archipelago and the strong tidal flows in and out of King Sound. We reach Cape Leveque in the afternoon, let down the tyre pressure, engage 4WD and sand drive to a pristine beach east of the Cape where swimming, fossicking for shells or relaxing is spread over 1-hour. Before departing back to Broome, we 4WD to the Western Beach to see the colours of the evening sun on the red cliffs of Cape Leveque.

**WHAT'S INCLUDED:**

Courtesy pick up and drop off from your Broome accommodation. Times will be advised upon booking. Morning tea, lunch and afternoon tea. Vegetarian meals catered for with prior notification. Cordial and cold water. Community entry fees. 1-hour Pearl Farm Tour. Trochus hatchery tour.

**WHAT TO BRING:**

Broad brimmed hat, swimming costume and towel, all round walking shoes/sandals for land and beach. Sun and insect protection i.e. long sleeves shirt, insect repellent, sunglasses and camera. Bring a water bottle – we refill it regularly with water or cordial.
