# 1-DAY

## CAPE LEVEQUE

with mud crabbing OR a visit to Cygnet Bay Pearl Farm

### WHAT'S INCLUDED?

Courtesy pick up and drop off from your Broome accommodation. Times will be advised upon booking. Morning tea, Lunch and Afternoon tea. Vegetarian meals catered for with prior notification. Cordial and cold water. Comfortable chairs and shade for lunch. Community entry fees, 1 hour mud crabbing tour and reef shoes for mud crabbing.

### WHAT TO BRING?

Broad rimmed hat, swimming costume and towel, all round walking shoes/sandals for land and water. Sun protection i.e. long sleeves shirt, insect repellent, sunglasses and camera. Bring a water bottle – we refill it regularly with water or cordial.



### 1-DAY WITH MUD CRABBING

Experience Cape Leveque in a day. Visit Beagle Bay Aboriginal Community to view the beautiful Sacred Heart Church, famous for its pearl shell altar. At low tide search for mud crabs in the mangroves and on the open intertidal flats along the coastline near Mudnunn with local guide Vincent Angus. Cook and sample what we catch with a delicious lunch. Drive onto the aboriginal community of Lombadina where you have the opportunity to purchase traditional handcrafted work (craft shop not open Sundays. Closed Wet

Season, Nov–Mar) and view the bush style community church. Reach Cape Leveque in the afternoon, let down the tyre pressure and engage the 4WD to sand drive to a pristine beach east of the cape where swimming, fossicking for shells or relaxing is spread over one hour. Before going back to Broome, 4WD down to the Western Beach to see the colours of the evening sun on the red cliffs of Cape Leveque.

DEPARTS: Tues, Thurs and Sun 6.45-7am  
RETURNS: approx 8.30-9pm

### 1-DAY WITH VISIT TO CYGNET BAY PEARL FARM

This tour includes a visit to the Beagle Bay Aboriginal Community. View the beautiful Sacred Heart Church, famous for its pearl shell altar. Then drive further north to Cygnet Bay Pearl Farm, Australia's oldest operating Pearl Farm and only recently opened to the public. Enjoy an informative 1 hour tour where you can learn about the family history, the process of culturing pearls and witness the day-to-day life of a pearl farmer. An opportunity to purchase pearls from last year's harvest "direct from the farm" is followed by a fantastic lunch prepared

by the farm's chefs. Drive onto One Arm Point Aboriginal Community and visit the local aquaculture hatchery then view the start of the Buccaneer Archipelago and the strong tidal flows of King Sound. Reach Cape Leveque in the afternoon, let down the tyre pressure, engage 4WD and sand drive to a pristine beach east of the Cape where swimming, fossicking for shells or relaxing is spread over 1 hour. Before departing back to Broome, 4WD down to the Western Beach to see the colours of the evening sun on the red cliffs of Cape Leveque.

DEPARTS: (Oct–Apr) Mon, Wed and Fri 6.45-7am (May–Sept ) Everyday 6.45-7am  
RETURNS: approx 8-8.30pm

### WHAT'S INCLUDED?

Courtesy pick up and drop off from your Broome accommodation. Times will be advised upon booking. Morning tea, lunch and afternoon tea. Vegetarian meals catered for with prior notification. Cordial and cold water. Community entry fees and 1 hour Pearl Farm Tour.

### WHAT TO BRING?

Broad rimmed hat, swimming costume and towel all round walking shoes/ sandals for land and water. Sun protection i.e. long sleeved shirt, insect repellent, sunglasses and camera. Bring a water bottle – we refill it regularly with water or cordial.



# 1-DAY

## DRIVE/FLY CAPE LEVEQUE

with mud crabbing OR visit to Cygnet Bay Pearl Farm

This tour includes all the highlights of the 1-day Cape Leveque tour with mud crabbing (provided low tide is in the morning) or with visit to Cygnet Bay Pearl farm and returns you to Broome before sunset. After the 4WD down to the Western Beach passengers board the plane at the Cape Leveque airstrip. Fly\* (50 minutes) directly over the Dampier Peninsula to Broome with aerial views of Lombadina, Beagle Bay, Willie Creek, Cable Beach and the township of Broome.

# 2-DAY

## CAPE LEVEQUE

with mud crabbing, visit to Cygnet Bay Pearl Farm AND tag-along tour to Swan Point

Includes all the highlights of 1-day Cape Leveque tour with mud crabbing and an overnight stay at Kooljaman Resort in comfortable tents with stretcher beds. The first day ends with optional self-guided sunset coastal walk around the beautiful red cliffs of Cape Leveque before a BBQ dinner.

PLUS: An enlightening morning on a 4WD tag-along tour with Tara Hunter. This tour involves a trip along the sandy coastline north of Hunter's Creek to Swan Point visiting areas that are normally 'off limits' to self drivers.

Enjoy some coastal fishing, reef walking (tide dependent) swimming and snorkelling. Morning tea is spent under the shade of a Gubinge tree next to a little protected bay south of Swan Point where we cook what we catch over a camp fire local style and you can talk to Tara and learn more about the lifestyle of the Bardi people in the region. Refreshed we visit the Cygnet Bay Pearl Farm for a 1 hour tour of their operation followed by a late lunch and the chance to purchase pearls from last year's harvest. Arrive back at Broome around 6.30 to 7pm.

DEPARTS: Tues and Sat 6.45-7am RETURNS: 6.30-7.30pm

### WHAT'S INCLUDED?

Courtesy pick up and drop off included. Times will be advised upon booking. Comfortable two man (high roof) tent, stretcher beds, mattress, fresh linen, sleeping bag & pillow. Clean showers and toilets in the Resort. **DAY 1:** Morning Tea, Lunch/Dinner. **DAY 2:** Breakfast, Morning Tea/Lunch. Any dietary requirements MUST be advised when booking. All entry fees, aboriginal tours, Cygnet Bay Pearl Farm tour, fishing gear/bait, reef shoes for mud crabbing.

### WHAT TO BRING?

Broad rimmed hat, swimming costume and towel, all round walking shoes/sandals for land and water, sun protection i.e. long sleeves shirt. Sunglasses, water bottle, camera. Bring a water bottle – we refill it regularly with water or cordial. BYO alcohol.

Looking to extend your 1-day and 2-day tour with more comfort than a tent? And learn more about the King Sound coastline? Try our overnight stays at Cygnet Bay Pearl Farm. Choose from sleeping on a luxury catamaran on The Bay (with crew) or staying in custom made safari tents.

Following your visit to the Cygnet Bay Pearl Farm on the 1-day and 2-day tour, we leave you at the farm to settle into your accommodation of choice, before an optional 3 hour sunset cruise with dinner onboard one of the farm's boats. Explore some of the creeks and bays around Cygnet Bay and experience a spectacular sunset over tranquil waters.

Alternatively, with advice from staff at the farm, enjoy self guided activities like fishing, coastal walks or sea kayaking. For those not wanting to self cater or participate in the sunset cruise, an evening 'Pearler's meal' is available in the farm's kitchen.

After breakfast the next morning you can pay to go on one of the optional guided tours^ (subject to tidal and weather conditions). This may include: exploring rock pools at low tide with the farm's marine biologist and tasting wild oysters; being dropped off alone on a private beach with hand held radio; or enjoying a high powered motor boat ride around the tidal creeks, beaches, islands and the farm at work.

Or you may enjoy doing your own thing and rejoin the next 1-day tour for lunch around 1pm and complete the days itinerary including One Arm Point Hatchery and Cape Leveque.

For people looking to stay longer on the farm so that they can take advantage of full day boating tours including a visit to Sunday Island and upgrade their accommodation to fully self contained units, please phone or email us for details.

## CAPE LEVEQUE

with mud crabbing, visit to Cygnet Bay Pearl Farm, tag-along tour to Swan Point AND sea kayaking down Chile Creek

This tour includes all the highlights of the 1-day Cape Leveque tour with mud crabbing, 2-day Cape Leveque tour with tag-along trip to Swan Point and visit to Cygnet Bay Pearl Farm and an extra nights camping at Kooljaman Resort. **PLUS:** Go for an eventful 3 hour paddle with Robert Sibosado on the tidal estuary of Chile Creek, just south of Lombadina. This tour operates only with the

larger spring tides (see time table top right) so that you go down the estuary with the falling tide and then come back up the estuary with the rising tide. See stingrays and fish swimming underneath your kayak. At low tide snorkel in still lagoons at the mouth of the estuary and find turtles. Before heading back to Broome we have a late lunch at the Aboriginal Community of Lombadina.

This trip starts with the 2-day Cape Leveque tour leaving Tuesday or Saturday. After lunch on the second day you are left at Kooljaman to do your own thing for the rest of the afternoon. On the third day you can relax on the beach, go for walks or participate in optional activities such as a scenic flight over the Buccaneer Archipelago or a boat trip around Kooljaman coast (ring Kooljaman office – 08 9192 4970 for availability). The fourth day is yours until around 3pm where upon you will be picked

up from the Kooljaman office and return to Broome with passengers travelling on our 1-day Cape Leveque tour. Ask about staying in a beach shelter or safari tent for that extra special experience.

DEPARTS: Tues and Sat 6.45-7am

RETURNS: approx 8.30-9pm

(ice can be purchased from resort). All entry fees, fishing gear/bait.

## VEHICLES and equipment



Chomley's Tours has 3 vehicles called Arkana's (extended and widened Toyota Landcruiser) with forward facing seats that can carry a maximum of only 10, 12 and 13 people to ensure a personalized tour. All our vehicles have a PA commentary system and are air-conditioned.



A custom built trailer provides easy access and plenty of space for all equipment including your luggage. All vehicles carry a sat phone and first aid kit for emergencies.

Chomley's Tours pride themselves of providing excellent equipment but without charging the earth. Our two man mozzie proof tents are high quality and you can stand upright in them. Beds are raised off the ground stretchers with inflatable comfort mats. Fresh linen, pillow and sleeping bag are provided



## FRIENDLY FACES

### Roger Chomley and his team

**ROGER CHOMLEY:** (Driver/guide) lives in Broome and has guided on the Dampier Peninsula for 7 years after working in Central Australia. He provides a keen insight into the plant habitats, history and geology of this diverse coastline and provides a thorough and entertaining commentary on his tours.



**ROBERT SIBOSADO:** (local guide for sea kayaking and snorkelling tour) is a resident of Lombadina and is heavily involved in promoting tourism for his community and the Dampier Peninsula.



The sea kayaking provides a unique way of showing his knowledge of the sea which is central to Bardi culture.

**VINCENT ANGUS:** grew up in Lombadina and moved to the outstation Mudnunn in the early 1990s where he established his mud crabbing tours. Mudnunn is his mother's traditional country whilst his father grew up on the Sunday Island mission. Vincent will work hard in finding that mud crab and help you share in the experience of dragging one out of its hiding spot with a steel hook.



**TARA HUNTER:** Bardi women and local guide for tag along tour from Hunter's Creek to Swan Point on the 2-day tour. Tara lives at One Arm Point where she grew up. She has intimate knowledge of the Hunter's Creek area, named after her great great grandfather who settled there in the early 1900's. Tara will shift the odds in our favor when it comes to catching fish for morning tea.



## TRANSFERS

### Dampier Peninsula

One way transfers are available to and from Cape Leveque, Cygnet Bay Pearl Farm, One Arm Point, Lombadina and Beagle Bay every day (subject to a confirmed tour). Arrival and departure times will depend on tour itinerary. Transfer price ranges from \$110 to \$200 depending on direction of transfer, participation in tour options and food requirements.

## Conditions of Tour

### DEAR CUSTOMER

Due to the fact that you will be travelling to remote locations where you will be participating in guided and non guided activities (i.e. walking, swimming and snorkelling) where mishaps can occur, you are required before paying for your tour to provide emergency contact details and acknowledge by signing the form where indicated, that you have read and accepted the conditions of this tour. This form is to be presented to the tour desk before purchasing your voucher/ticket and handed to your guide with your voucher/ticket upon pickup.

Please note it is felt these tours are not suitable for pregnant women or people with back problems. Depending on the condition of the road we can take up to 7 hours to complete the 460 km round trip on the 1-day tour or 3 hours to complete the Broome to Cape Leveque leg.

**CANCELLATION POLICY:** Fees will be charged in event of booking cancellations. Within 7 days – 100% of fare, 8 to 14 days notice 50% of fare. Beyond 14 days notice 10% of fare.

**TRAVEL INSURANCE:** Travel Insurance is NOT included. We strongly recommend clients have their own insurance against illness, loss/damage to personal belongings and not being able to travel on the confirmed departure.

**LIABILITY:** Whilst every precaution will be taken for the safety of passengers no liability of any kind whatsoever can be taken in the event of death, accident, injury, loss or damage to person and property or cost of emergency evacuation on these tours. This exclusion of liability shall apply to and be for the benefit of Chomley's Tours agents, servants and representatives.
